



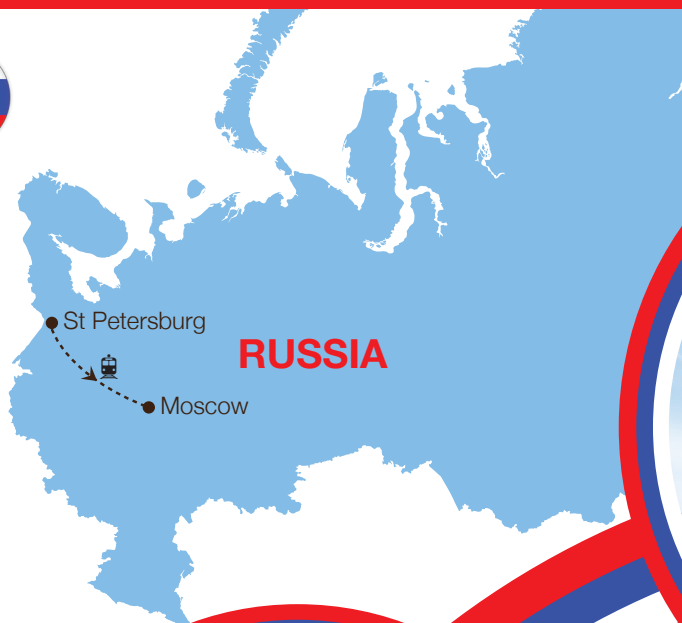

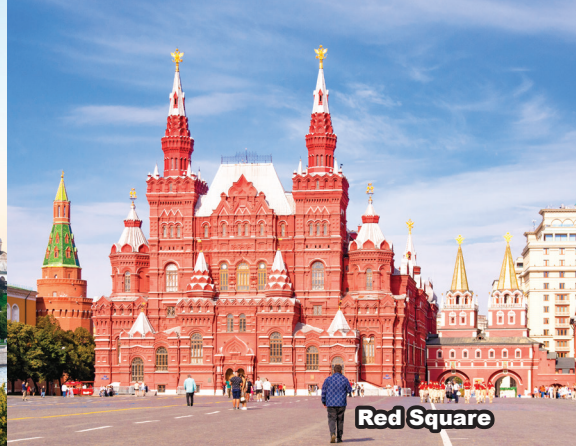

ST PETERSBURG

- The Nevsky Prospekt** - Today functions as the main thoroughfare om St Petersburg. The majority of the city's shopping and nightlife are located on or right off the Nevsky Prospekt.
- Kazan Cathedral** - Also known as the Cathedral of Our Lady of Kazan, it is a cathedral of the Russian Orthodox Church on the Nevsky Prospekt and deicated to Our Lady of Kazan, probaly the most venerated icon in Russia. The construction was started in 1801 and continued for ten years while being supervised by Alexander Sergeyevich Stroganov.
- The Peter and Paul Fortress** - It is the original citadel of St Petersburg, Russia, founded by Peter the Great in 1703 and built to Domenico Trezzini's designs from 1706 to 1740. In the early 1920s, it was still used as a prison and execution ground by the bolshevik government. Today it has been adapted as the central and the most important part of the State Museum of Saint Petersburg history. The museum has gradually become virtually the sole owner of the fortress building, except the structure occupied by the Saint Petersburg Mint.
- Hermitage Museum** - A museum of art and culture in St Petersburg and also one of the largest and oldest museum in the world, it was founded in 1764 by Catherine the Great hand has been open to the public since 1852. Its collections, of which only a small part is on permanent display, comprise over three million items (the numismatic collection accounts for about one third of them) including the largest collection of paintings in the world.
- Nikolaevski Palace** - The Palace of Grand Duke Nikolai Nikolaievich of Russia forms part of a sprawling complex incorporating a palatial church, a manege and several outbuildings separated from Labour Square by a cast-iron fence.
- Neva River Boat Cruise (valid for Summer season from Jul to Aug)** - Embark on a river cruise to view the famed draw bridges from below, to enjoy the fresh air from the Gulf of Finland. Witness with a most dramatic and beautiful scenery.

MOSCOW

- **Sparrow Hills** - It is the name of a location in the south-west of Moscow, positioned on the high right bank of the Moscow River and covered in forest. It is located opposite Luzhnikov, one of the seven hills of Moscow. The hills stretch from the mouth of the River Setuna to the Andreev Bridge (on the small ring of the Moscow railroad). In the north, they are bordered by the Neskuchny garden.
- **Red Square** - It is a city square (plaza) in Moscow, it separates the Kremlin, the former royal citadel and currently the official residence of the President of Russia, from a historic merchant quarter known as Kitai-gorod. It is also considered the central square of Moscow since Moscow's major streets which connect to Russia's highways, originate from the square.
- **St Basil's Cathedral** - Commonly known as the Cathedral of Vasily the Blessed, it is a church in Red Square. The building now a museum, officially known as the Cathedral of the intercession of the Most Holy Theotokos on the Moat of Pokrovsky Cathedral. It was built from 1556 - 1561 on orders from Ivan the Terrible and commemorates the capture of Kazan and Astrakhan. A world famous landmark, it was the city's tallest building till the completion of the Ivan the Great Bell Tower in 1600.
- **Kremlin** - The name Kremlin means "fortress inside a city". It is a fortified complex at the heart of Moscow, overlooking the Moskva River to the south, St Basil's Cathedral and Red Square to the east and the Alexander Garden to the west. It is the best know of the kremlins (Russian citadels) and includes five palaces, four cathedrals and the enclosing Kremlin Wall with Kremlin towers.
- **Moscow Metro** - One of the world's most beautiful subway systems. Famous for its grand Soviet-era architecture, marble halls, chandeliers, and mosaic art. It's fast, affordable, and connects major attractions across the city, making it both a transport system and an underground museum for travelers.
