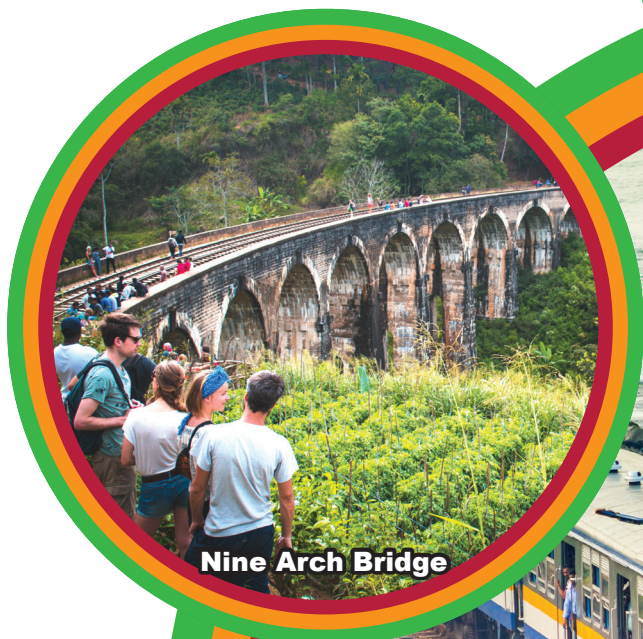

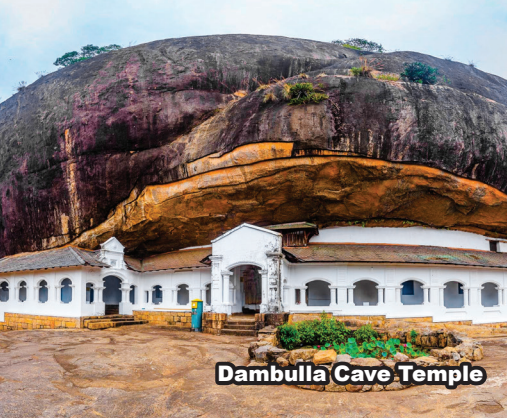

NEGOMBO

- **The Negombo Fishing Village** – Known locally as Lellama, this bustling open air market near the Old Dutch Gate is Sri Lanka's second largest. Watch hundreds of boats unload the day's catch and browse for tuna, squid, jumbo prawns, lobster, and the famous Negombo Crab. ** The fish market is closed on Sundays and public holidays. **

DAMBULLA

- **Dambulla Cave Temple** – A UNESCO World Heritage Site (1991) in central Sri Lanka, Dambulla is the country's largest and best preserved cave temple complex. Rising 160 m above the plains, it features over 80 caves, with five main ones housing vivid paintings and 160+ statues of Buddha, Sri Lankan kings, and Hindu deities such as Vishnu and Ganesha.

SIGIRIYA

- **Sigiriya or Sinhadagiri (Lion Rock)** – Located near Dambulla in Sri Lanka's Central Province, Sigiriya was chosen by King Kashyapa (AD 477–495) as his capital. He built a palace atop the rock, adorned its sides with colorful frescoes, and created a grand lion-shaped gateway halfway up. After his death, the site was abandoned as a capital and later served as a Buddhist monastery until the 14th century.

KANDY

- **Temple of the Sacred Tooth Relic** – Also called Sri Dalada Maligawa, this sacred Buddhist temple in Kandy's former royal palace complex houses the revered Tooth Relic of the Buddha. Believed to symbolize sovereignty, the relic played a central role in Sri Lankan history. Kandy, the last royal capital, was declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1988 largely due to this temple.

NUWARA ELIYA

- **Nuwara Eliya** – also known as "Little England", is a city in the hill It is at an altitude of 1,868 m (6,128 ft) and is the most important location for tea production in Sri Lanka. The city is overlooked by Pidurutalagala, the tallest mountain in Sri Lanka. Nuwara Eliya is known for its temperate, cool climate – the coolest area in Sri Lanka.

YALA

- Yala National Park** – renowned for its rich wildlife, Yala offers one of the world's highest chances to spot leopards, while also being the best place in Sri Lanka to see wild elephants, often present in large numbers around the scrub jungle and waterholes.
**Sightings of leopards are not guaranteed and are strictly subject to animal behavior, as they are wild animals*

KOGGALA

- Stilt Fishing** – One of Sri Lanka's most unique traditions, stilt fishing began after World War II and was revived after the 2004 tsunami. At dawn, noon, and dusk, fishermen perch skillfully on poles to catch fish along the southern coast in towns like Koggala, Kaththaluwa, and Ahangama. Occasional stilt fishermen can also be seen on the Madu River.

GALLE

- Galle Fort** – Set in the Bay of Galle on Sri Lanka's southwest coast, this UNESCO World Heritage Site blends European architecture with South Asian traditions. Once a colonial stronghold, it now hosts a vibrant multi-ethnic community. The fort's heritage value has inspired efforts to recognize it as one of the modern wonders of the world.

BALAPITIYA

- Madu River Boat Safari** – explore the mangrove and the biodiversity of the Madu River and admire the beauty of the Madu River and a different kind of healing. Madu ganga is situated in Balapitiya. It opens to the Indian Oceans Madu lagoon is a very wide and a beautiful lagoon in Sri Lanka. It is in the wet zone of Sri Lanka with a high biodiversity. Madu River has been proclaimed a Ramsa wetland in the world in 2004.
